POSTGRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION

RESIDENT TRAVEL GRANTS

A limited amount of funding is available to support resident conference travel to present research conducted at the University of Calgary. The Medical Staff Trust Fund and a grant from Alberta Health and Wellness are the funding sources.

The resident must:

- Be first author on the abstract
- Present new and original research (not presented before)
- Submit a one-page abstract that includes the following
 - Title and author(s)
 - Background of the study (research question and rationale)
 - Methods (research design, sample, and type of analysis)
 - Results (data and statistical analysis)
 - Discussion (interpretation and implications of the results)

Note:

Case reports and literature reviews are not eligible under the travel grant program (a meta-analysis is acceptable). PMGE resident funding may be used to cover expenses for this type of presentation.

Application guidelines:

- The grant (maximum of \$2,000.00 per resident per conference) covers the costs of travel, accommodation and registration fees for the conference and may be available upon application to the Associate Dean, Postgraduate Medical Education.
- Application for a travel grant must be made a minimum of four (4) weeks in advance of the travel departure date.
- Application must be made on the "Application for Resident Travel Grant" form and be signed by the responsible Program Director. A copy of a) the conference abstract and b) the letter of abstract acceptance must accompany the application.
- Grants will be issued on a first-come-first-served basis to residents meeting the criteria for a grant.
- Travel must be completed during residency.
- All Ministry-funded University of Calgary residents in RCPSC or CFPC programs are eligible.

APPLICATION FOR RESIDENT TRAVEL GRANT

Applicant must be full-time in a residency program. A maximum of \$2000.00 may be awarded to the resident traveling to a conference to present original research conducted at the University of Calgary.

The following must be submitted to the PGME Office:

- Completed Application Form
- A copy of the Conference Abstract
- Confirmation of Acceptance of the Abstract for Presentation
