

Tax Tips

As a resident physician, you should receive the following tax forms from Alberta Health Services usually by mid March:

- Statement of Remuneration Paid (T4)
- Declaration of Conditions of Employment (T2200)

If you have any questions or do not receive either of these forms, contact payroll at Edmonton (780) 735-0340 (Edmonton) or (403) 699-0505 (Calgary).

The following forms are available from your university for download:

NOTE: As per the attached poster from Alberta Health Services, remember to submit your health spending account claims for expenses occurred in 2010 before the end of February. Your unused 2010 credits will be rolled over until December 31, 2011. Note that, if you have not already, you can submit your last December paystub to claim your health and dental deductions.
