1. **PARA - Know Your Contract:**

• **Banking Vacation**

Vacation is intended to be taken in the (contract/academic) year in which it is earned. Article 12.05 states:

Vacation shall be taken within the period of engagement. Provided the Program Director and the appropriate representative of the Authority gives prior approval, if a Resident is unable to take their vacation in one year because of service commitments, the unused time may be banked except in the situation where the Resident is in their final year of training, in which case the Resident will be paid in lieu of vacation time. Any dispute or disagreement between an affected member of **PARA** and a Program Director or Authority representative may be referred to the relevant Associate Dean who will consult with **PARA** before making a final decision.

Rolling vacation into the upcoming PGY year is discouraged; this option is possible, but only under a *very* selective set of circumstances. To bank vacation for the next year, resident physicians must be unable to take their vacation time in the correct year because of service commitments *and* have the prior approval of their Program Director *and* an appropriate representative of AHS to bank this vacation. Resident physicians with outstanding vacation time from their final year of training will have this vacation paid out rather than rolled over. **If you think you may end up having unused vacation time this year, make sure you get prior documented approval from your Program Director and AHS.** Program Directors should be notifying PGME when resident physicians have been unable to use vacation.

• **Health Spending Account Changes**

Effective January 1, 2011, expenses for purely cosmetic procedures will no longer be eligible for reimbursement under your Health Spending Account.

A cosmetic expense will continue to qualify for tax free reimbursement from a Health Spending Account if it is required for medical or reconstructive purposes. Examples would include surgery to address a deformity related to a congenital abnormality, a personal injury resulting from an accident or trauma, or a disfiguring disease.

Examples of expenses that will generally be *ineligible* after January 1, 2011 include:

- augmentations and body modifications shaping, contouring, or lifts;
- botulinum treatments, filler injections;

- hair removal or replacement procedures;
- liposuction;
- teeth whitening, tooth contouring, reshaping.

Note:

You should contact a tax expert to confirm the tax status of any Health Spending Account reimbursement(s) you received for cosmetic procedures performed after March 4, 2010. 2. Call for **PARA** Executive Nominations

PARA will be accepting nominations for the 2011/2012 Executive from now until January 15, 2011. Members of the 2011/2012 **PARA** Executive will have the opportunity to attend the executive retreat in Canmore or Banff on the weekend of June 4th - 6th. Executive members are responsible for implementing direction set by the Board of Directors; through this role, resident physicians can access opportunities to fulfil a number of CanMEDs roles: develop their leadership skills, liaise with health and medical education stakeholders, and represent Alberta's resident physicians at the regional, provincial, and national levels.

Elections for positions on the Executive Committee shall be held as follows:

- Nominations for Executive positions shall be solicited from the Board and from the entire membership; only general members are eligible for nomination. The nomination deadline is January 15th.
- If there is more than one nominee for a position, an on-line ballot will be mailed to each member of **PARA**. These ballots shall have the names of all nominees listed with a brief biography and platform description from each of the nominees. Elections will close on February 15th.
- The ballots will be tabulated by survey software. The candidate with the most votes for each position will be the "Director Elect" for that position. The names of the Directors Elect shall then be posted in the next communiqué to the membership. The new executive will take office July 1st.
- In cases of electoral dispute, a ruling shall be made by the Past President who shall act as the Chief Returning Officer, unless he/she is running for another executive position, in which case, the President shall take on this role.
