What is a resident physician?

- Resident physicians are licensed doctors who have completed medical school and are now undergoing additional training in a specialized field of medicine.
- Residency training typically lasts between two to seven years, depending on the specialty.
- Residents deliver direct patient care while continuing their education.
- In Alberta, residency training is conducted through the University of Alberta and the University of Calgary.
