Rural Education Supplement and Integrated Doctor Experience (RESIDE)


- Supports new-in-practice physicians to live work, and strive in rural Alberta with a financial benefit & support integrating into the community
- Targeted to family doctors who will be graduating or have graduated from a Canadian residency program in the last five years
- Application Deadline: March 31, 2024





General Emergency Medicine Skills (GEMS) Course

- For physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, nurses, and other members of rural emergency teams
- Online, multimedia emergency-skills training to upgrade emergency medical skills
- Upon completion, Hands-on Human Patient Simulation Session provided via Shock Trauma Air Rescue Society (STARS) for eligible health professionals



Continuing Education Bursaries for Rural Care Providers

 Facilitate rural health professional access to pre-selected rural health-care conferences in Alberta

Physician Skills Enrichment

- Physicians identify their own training needs
- Program supports physicians to access learning opportunities that meet those needs
